#### FEDERATION COMMUNITY PROJECTS PROGRAM: PROGRESS REPORT

Representatives of community groups in the Romsey area met together for a second time on 5<sup>th</sup> October to consider projects to mark the Centenary of Federation, and in particular the proposal to construct a bike path suitable for all ages. Other proposals were suggested and for various reasons put aside.

Three members at the meeting put costed proposals on the table and after much discussion it was decided by show of hands that the best proposal was a bike path between the towns of Romsey and Lancefield. This proposal has the advantage of being used by both young and older, and it is hoped that it could receive support from, and be used by, both communities.

It is essential that any project should meet the criteria set out which are:

- · suitably mark the Centenary of Federation
- be representative of community aspirations, and should be supported by community groups with agreement to be involved in the project.
- have benefits for communities in that positive employment outcomes are provided, be of enduring value, and provide broad community involvement,
- demonstrate good management with realistic budgeting, financial and project management, and completion by or during the year 2001,
- demonstrate partnerships in funding as preference will be given to applications that have significant financial and in kind support from the private sector, local communities and other sources.

Letters of support for this bike path project are requested from community groups and individuals in both Lancefield and Romsey and should be sent to Margaret Howartson at the Romsey Medical Centre as soon as possible, as application close on October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1998.

#### VISIT FROM INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE:

At the beginning of September, Little Athletics sponsored a visit from Paul Cleary to talk to the local schools about his chosen sport and to conduct Athletic Clinics with them. Paul was terrific with the kids although a touch modest when discussing his own achievements. Paul is only 22 now and by 1996 he had already won the Australian 1500m Championship. He set the Australian Under 20 record - 3.38.39 - for the same event. He attended the World Junior Championships in Portugal and finished sixth in the final. In 1996 he won the NEC Classic in Melbourne, in the process beating the great Moses Kiptanui and the Olympic Champion Moses Tanui. He competed in the Atlanta Olympics. Competing in Ireland before the Olympics he caught a virus which later became a post virus syndrome or chronic fatigue syndrome. Paul is still trying to reach the level he was at ain 1996. He trains twice a day at Olympic Park under coach Peter Fortune.

A point of interest to all Little Athletics (especially the older ones who are somewhat haphazard about their warm-ups) is that Paul spends over 40 minutes warming up before starting training! We would like to thank Paul for coming up to see us and wish him all the best. Hopefully we will be seeing him compete against the internationals next February.

#### **COUNCIL NEWS: MONEGEETTA WARD:**

First an update on natural gas. Westar have now completed their market research report on the demand of gas in Macedon Ranges towns. Based on this report they will be able to estimate the potential consumption of gas in each town. They are currently estimating the costs of a number of alternative routes, which should be completed shortly, and also considering a number of technical innovations in the network design to minimise costs. Market and financial evaluations to determine if these alternatives will be viable are next. In terms of privatisation, the Office of Regulator General has recently announced a delay to the final determinations on Access Arrangements and Tariff Order until November. These two documents stipulate the conditions on the supply of gas. Kinetik Energy and Westar will not be able to make a final decision on our proposals until these two documents are finalised.

The Valuation of Land Act has been amended to require that a General Valuation of all rateable properties within the Shire take place every two years. The previous requirement for non-metropolitan Councils was six years. The Macedon Ranges Shire last conducted a General Valuation with an "effective date" of December 31, 1995. This valuation was first applied to Council's property database for the 1996/97 rating year. The "effective date" is the date at which all property valuations are set. As a consequence of the amended legislation, Council is required to return its next General Valuation at the effective date of January 1, 2000 with the new valuation applied in the 1000/01 rating year. Your new valuation will be a multiplier to determine how much in rates you will pay, not only to Council but also to Western Water.

Traffic movement priority will be altered at the intersection of Bolinda-Darraweit Road, Darraweit Wallan Road and Stockdale Road in Darraweit Guim. N future traffic travelling east on the Bolinda-Darraweit Road will be facing a 'Give Way' sign as will motorists exiting the school car park, with traffic travelling north-south along Stockdale Road and Darraweit-Wallan Road having 'right-of-way'. Also residents of Riddells Creek will notice that they can no longer travel into Hamilton Street from Station or Stephens Streets. Persons detected offending will no doubt be making a voluntary fiscal contribution to the coffers of our State Government.

Finally, for those that are interested, Council has a debt of \$9,883,294 (including superannuation "black hole" liability) which basically equates to \$300/resident. As at 18.1.95, the date of amalgamation, Romsey Shire had a debt of \$99/resident. Till next time. (Cr.) Geoff Neil Phone/Fax 5429 6785.

Lancefield Romsey Little Athletics Centre (A0034129Y)

Little Athletics is about to commence it's eleventh season in our area. The Centre started at Lancefield in 1997 and moved to Romsey in 1994 after battling late starts to the season on the flooded oval behind Lancefield Primary. Facilities and equipment now boast a full 400m grass running track, 90m hurdles track, concrete throwing rings, large sandpit for the long and triple jump, two large high jump mats and a new set of hurdles to try out this year.

Through fees from more than 200 children over the decade and invaluable sponsorship from local businesses the Centre has built a resource to be admired. Through the hardwork of parents the running surface is continually being improved and equipment levels upgraded.

The Centre will operate on Saturday mornings from October 3 to March 27 next year. Warm-up starts at 9.15 and competition is usually finished by 11.15 (some big city centre start at 8.30 and finish well after midday). We run all the standard events such as high, long and triple jump, hurdles, javelin, discus, shot put and running events from 70m up to 1500m. Due to our small size we can provide extra events (especially for the younger athletes), combine or change age groups to suit the athletes and also coach during competition (unheard-of at centres where they are trying to get 400 kids through the event each Saturday!). Our Centre provides a competition where the kids spend more time doing and less time watching!

### Family Fun Fitness

Our Centre follows the Little Athletics motto of 'Family Fun Fitness'. We encourage children to develop their skills and fitness in all events in a supporting environment. We compete against other centres in our area and if our athletes qualify they can compete at the State Championships. At the end of the season we organise or own Centre Championships where medallions (sponsored by O'Deas Auto Spares) are awarded to the athletes. During the season the athletes are all in the running for the 'Athlete of the Year' award. This award recognises sporting behaviour, results in competition and of primary importance skills development where each improvement in performance gets maximum points.

### Essential Ingredients

To run an effective program the essential ingredients are athletes, equipment and 'officials'. This last ingredient is the 'Family' in our motto. The children need help to measure, start, time, encourage, coach, pick them up, laugh with them, marvel at them and the hundreds of other things that happen on our Saturday mornings. No experience necessary and a regular commitment is not essential. Come down when you can and see how well your child is doing.

Fees are set as low as possible - \$35 for the first child in the family and less for the others. Uniforms are cheap and are really only needed at outside competitions. We have sausage sizzles, icypole days and novelty days. Be warned that we also have a day where the parents compete against the kids (geriatrics versus juveniles). Some of us go down to the International Athletics meetings in Melbourne to see how it should be done.

### LEGAL NEWS

#### NEW VENDOR DISCLOSURE OBLIGATIONS

A vendor's statement (or section 32 Statement) discloses information about a property being sold which may affect a purchaser. It must be shown to a purchaser before he or she signs a contract and if it is inaccurate in any way, the purchaser may be able either to withdraw from the sale or take action against the vendor.

Section 32 of the Sale of Land Acr 1962 sets out the information which must be included in a vendor's statement. Section 32(1A), which commenced operation on 1 August 1997, now requires details of guarantees and insurance to be given in the vendor's statement in specified circumstances.

Vendors are now required to disclose:

- any building permit in the past seven years (this is not new);
- details of any guarantee imposed on ownerbuilders under the House Contracts Guarantee Act 1987 in the past seven years (this also is not new); and
- details of required insurance covering building works to residences to which s137B of the Building Act 1993 applies and which have been carried out in the past six years and six months.

Section 137B of the Building Act imposes obligations on a person who builds a house and then sells it. It also applies to registered builders selling a house that they have constructed on their own land. It requires registered builders, prior to selling a house, to be covered by insurance and to provide a number of warranties in relation to the quality of the work and materials used.

Section 137B of the Building Act requires owner-builders (or vendors who have carried out renovations and extensions to their own properties) to comply with the insurance requirements and, in addition, owner-builders must also provide a building inspector's report to the purchaser. The report must not be more than six months old. This obligation applies not

only to the construction of a residence but also to renovations and extensions.

If the vendor does not comply with these requirements, he or she can be liable to a penalty and the contract will be voidable by the purchaser at any time up until completion of the contract.

This new legislation affects the sale of any residence where building works have been carried out in the past six and a half years and will affect the obligations of registered builders and owner-builders who are selling a house and all vendors generally. It also

substantially alters the rights of purchasers. It is important to obtain legal advice before signing a contract.


