Knitters wanted

Wanted. Knitters to help break a record.

The Australian Red Cross has embarked on the idea of having the World's Largest Knitted Rug made to raise public awareness for Red Cross Calling in March next year.

Kyneton Unit Red Cross members are joining in to knit and inviting others to join them.

On March 4, the official launch of Red Cross Calling will be held at Government House in Melbourne and permission has been sought from the Governor, Sir James Gobbo, to cover the lawns of Government House with this, hopefully, record-breaking rug. Each Unit has been asked to knit squares that will be joined together for the record. Afterwards, they will be taken apart and sent to various places for use.

To participate, the following rules are a must.

- . Pure new eight ply Australian will to be used.
- . Use size 8 (4mm) needles (average knitters).
- . Final rug to be three foot square (90cm).
- . Must be knitted not crocheted.

Options:

- . Pattern - your choice
- . Color - plain or multicolored
- . Stitch - endless possibilities.

Recommendations:

- . Darn ends in as you go
- . Don't tie knots - put two ends together and knit them double for 4 inches (10 cms) or darn ends in.

All completed rugs must be returned to Kyneton Unit by January 27 so they can be sent to the Zone Office by February 1.

COUNCIL NEWS – MONEGEETTA WARD

Council is providing free tipping of green waste material from Saturday Nov. 27th to Sunday Jan. 3rd, inclusive at any of our waste management centres (they used to be called a tip!). Rather than burning off green waste material such as tree heads, branches, leaf litter and lawn clippings, why not take up this offer. Fire restrictions are imminent and open air burning will be prohibited. Council has signed off on the Community Funding Scheme applications. It was great to see so many applications from groups with the former Romsey Shire. The result was that of the \$97,000 available, \$32,00 will be distributed 'over here'. I am aware that many groups were not funded and can only urge those people to apply again next year. Streetscape works in Riddells Creek to the value of \$50,000 are expected to be advertised in the next week or so. If you are in to landscaping then read the Council column in local papers. Tenders are due to close soon include design work for a new bridge over the railway line on Gisborne-Kilmore Road, Riddells Creek (\$45,000), and Romsey Mechanics Institute renovations (\$100,000). Also the reconstruction/replacement of Dalys Bridge (\$500,000) on the Romsey-Wallan Road is due late Jan, Feb. and early March, 2000. There will be some traffic delays and certainly detours in place for approximately 6 weeks. Please be patient.

Council has determined to employ a part-time youth worker to assist Liz Wynne, Council's Youth Development Officer. Our youth make up a substantial part of this Shire's population and Council is committed to ensuring that their needs are addressed. Nominations for Citizen, Young Citizen and Community Achievement Awards are being called for. The aim of these awards is to recognise outstanding contribution to the community at large throughout the year. For further information please contact Stephen Mahon on 1300 656 577. I am pleased to announce that Council has accepted the nomination of Steven Krystic, a local resident and Veterinarian to it Environment Advisory Committee. Steve is well qualified for the position by being a Master of Natural Resource (Landscape Ecology) amongst other attributes.

Finally, being the last Romsey Rag for this year, Pam and I wish all residents a very Merry Christmas and successful new millennium. Please take care on the roads over the festive season.
